## Before the Airport:

### DO NOT PACK THE FOLLOWING IN CHECKED BAGS

- Jewelry
- Cash
- Laptop computers
- Electronics
- Wrapped gifts
- Fragile items (no matter how they are protected)
- Film (the screening equipment will damage it)
- Loose lithium batteries (not allowed)
- Keep batteries and equipment with you, or in carry-on baggage - not in your checked baggage!

### WHAT/HOW TO PACK

- Don't stack books
- Remember ID tags inside and out
- Bring an empty container for ZamZam
- Use TSA approved locks
- Keep Zam Zam in checked luggage.

### CARRY-ON BAGS

- Pack your coats in bags
- Put liquids in 3oz. containers in a plastic bag
- No matches or lighters
- Label your laptop
- Pen and Paper

## WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT

## Prohibited items:

- Scissors, metal with pointed tips
- Box Cutters
- Ice Axes/Ice Picks
- Knives (except round-bladed, butter, and plastic cutlery)
- Meat Cleavers
- Razor-Type Blades, such as box cutters, utility knives, razor blades not in a cartridge, but excluding safety razors
- Sabers
- Swords
- Crowbars
- Hammers
- Drills
- Saws
- Screwdrivers (except those in eyeglass repair kits)
- Tools
- Wrenches and Pliers
- Martial Arts/Self Defense Items
- Explosive Materials
- Flammable Items
- Disabling Chemicals
- Chlorine for Pools and Spas
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Liquid Bleach
- Spillable Batteries
- Spray Paint
- Tear Gas

## Dress for Success:

Avoid wearing clothing, jewelry, or other accessories that contain metal, gold, steel, or brass.

### AS YOU APPROACH THE CHECKPOINT:

- Hang up the cell phone
- Remove sunglasses
- Have ID ready
- Be polite, don't make jokes
